FISHING REPORT

From Jeff Becker on the "Beats working."

Jim and I with guest anglers Jay Sauber and Chris Elkins went bottom fishing on Thursday Oct 20th. Very difficult conditions with 3 plus knots of tide all day long and at times 4 plus knots.. Took 20 oz of weights to get down to the fish.. We actually needed more weight but there is a point where it is simply not worth the effect. Cranking up 20oz against a 3 knot current is not fun. Despite the difficult conditions (failed to mention feeling a triggerfish bite with 20oz of weight is extremely challenging) we managed to have an ok catch: 16 2-3 lb triggerfish, 5 red snapper releases, 4 very nice sea bass, 3 beeliners, 2 porgies, 4 released grouper,. Planned on king fishing but the bite is very inconsistent, so the dark side was our best option. King report coming once they show up as well as catching (hopefully) a bluefin tuna to celebrate my 70 birthday.. This getting old sucks

NEWS RELEASE FROM THE CAPE HATTERAS ANGLERS CLUB RESULTS OF THE 64th ANNUAL SURF FISHING TOURNAMENT

The Cape Hatteras Anglers Club 64th Annual Invitational Surf Fishing Tournament was held November 2-5, 2022. 118 teams participated in this year's tournament and caught a total of 1,155 fish. This tournament is the largest of its kind in the world, with 120 teams and 720 anglers participating. It attracts over 800 visitors to Hatteras Island for the week.

Results

Surfside Anglers, of Kill Devil Hills, took first place men and overall, with 56 fish totaling 160 points. The team Captain was Kevin Jacobs, with members Casey Copeland, Brad Harrall, Jake Sanders, Danny Jacobs and Jeff Hitt. The Surfside Anglers scored 120 of their 160 points in the first session in spite of rain and thunder.

Placing second men was Fish Hoggs Eastern Shore VA Anglers of Parksley, VA with 48 fish and 109 points. Captain Marty Bull lead his teammates Brian Hill, Ray Willett, Clark Crocket, Jamie Logan and Dean Carroll to a second-place men finish with consistent scoring of fish each session.

Placing third men was Ocean City Fishing Club of NJ with35 fish and 98 points. Captain Bob Dever rallied his teammates Tyler Daley, Ed Parkinson, Sami Catalano, Augie Conte III and Drew Furst with an impressive fourth session.

First Place Women was Queen Mackerels, of Kill Devil Hills, with 13 fish for 38 points. Captain Maggie Garris and her teammates Peggy Byrd, Linda Donningan, Linda Harper, Dee Deaton Jones and Wendy Hall took the lead in the Women's Division from the first session and held it for the remainder of the tournament.

Placing second women, first time awarded in this tournament, was Showstoppers of Kill Devil Hills with 15 fish and 35 points. Captain Hazel Basnight and her teammates Karen Graf, Anne Smith, Vicki Basnight, Annah Petty and Virginia Perlot landed 11 fish for 28 points in the first session.

Placing third women, also first time awarded at this tournament, was Island Girls of Buxton with 10 fish for 31 points. Captain Nancy Giannotti lead her teammates Kitty Squire, Kathy Walke, Iris Long, Michelle VanWagner and Carla Meekins with the first and last scoring fish of the tournament. Nags Head Surf Fishing Club tied for third in points, but claimed fourth place women by tiebreaker rules.

Club Website Improvements — from Tripp Adams:

With the help from Tom Zemonek and Janson Fant, the club has a new website. We launched the new RSWSC website in November of 2020.

Built on a different platform from the old site, the club site now has a more updated and professional look/feel. You will notice many of the tabs from the original site are the similar, with only a few key differences. Users will experience much faster load times and, a webpage made to fit mobile devices.

The other new feature is the 'Forum' tab. https://rswsc.org/forum visitors to the website will have to make an account to access the information. The idea behind the forum is that, this will be a great way for members to interact with each other, especially during these quarantine times. Several message board topics have already been created in the forum; members can post pictures, experiences with guide services, baits/tactics, etc. This will also be a great way for members to meet other club member who have experience in their area of the coast.

As we continue to grow into the new website, you may notice changes along the way. While much of the site was built before it was published, there are always new features that can be added or adjusted. in the long term the site should be able to handle club communication for both emails and social media postings. Some of this will be a "learn as we go" process so, bear with us.
